- IV. \*Discussion/for Possible Action - **Approval of September 8, 2020 Meeting Minutes Mary Kerner made a motion to approve the 09/08/2020 meeting minutes. Bill Wilson seconded the motion. The motion passed.**

Liaison Report **Laurie Carson reported that CRM has tried to have one phone call meeting, it was not well attended and this did not work out, this was part of the fact that the BLM is still closed. The next meeting is scheduled for December 4<sup>th</sup>. There is an OHV meeting scheduled for October 20, 2020, this is the CRM subcommittee.**

  - A. \*Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – **Bureau of Land Management No one was present**
  - B. \*Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – **U.S. Forest Service Jose Noriega reported that the Forest Service is currently dealing with wild horses, they are breaking fences to get to the last of the vegetation. The drought is currently causing major issues. They have not received an appeal on the citation they issued. They are increasing fees at their camp grounds.**

- E. **\*Update/Discussion/for Possible Action – RCI, Jeremy Drew Jeremy Drew reported that on tomorrows commission meeting they are putting together comments on the Water Hearings, the concerns are not only with the process but also with the speed they are trying to push through, 58 basins in a two week period. The basins discussed today were Long Valley, Spring Valley, Pleasant Valley, Snake Valley, and the southern portion of Butte Valley. In Newark Valley they are proposing a stipulation that there would be no preference for irrigation. They are saying any current manner of use cannot be switched to irrigation use. The suggestion to the commission, will be White Pine County cannot support any of the designations, because lack of information and lack of current data. They are also tracking the White Pine Pump Storage Project, the comment period is due at the end of the month, they are presenting a draft comment letter to the Commission on the 10/28/2020 meeting. The future items they are tracking are Department of Interior is updating their entire grazing regulations, the draft EIS will be out later in the year. The USFS Greater Sage-grouse objection period is still pending.**
