PUBLIC COMMENT: Heather asked for the support of the County Commission in opposing the Cedar City Water Development Project at the last County Commission Meeting.

>**Update: Baker Dark Sky Community.** Next steps: talk with Mount Wheeler Power about fixture requirements to mount on existing poles. Funds raised: \$13,683.00.

>**Discussion/Possible Action: Lighted Speed Limit Signs for Baker.** Request for another study to be conducted by NDOT, or place the signs on private property outside the NDOT right-of-way.

Dead Trees along Highway 488: Baker Ranches will use equipment to knock down and clear out dead vegetation in the old irrigation ditch outside of town on 488.
