Minutes of Meeting for

March 8, 2022

After the pledge, Chairman Jimmy Allred brought the meeting to order. Jimmy started public comment by mentioning that he called Steve Behr with the State and he is out of the office for medical reasons. He will be calling Eric Trujillo this next week to discuss the LED road signs that we want for each end of Lund.

Gilbert Griffin suggested that we find a candidate from our valley to run for county commissioner. Jimmy said that he will be running in the next election. Jimmy is hoping to start going to the county commissioner meeting starting April. There can be more than two from Lund, we really need representation from our community.

Ann Hamilton made a motion to approve the minutes of February 8, 2022 as written, Lee Ringueberg seconded that motion and all members approved.

Motion to give the secretary a raise was under consideration, that item has been tabled for now.

Vouchers for payment secretary wages motioned by Christina Rimington and seconded by Ann. All members approved.

Shawn Hamilton has started one cleanup project down behind the Faught residence. Jimmy is working on cleaning up junk cars in town. Denny's Automotive will be coming to pick those up. Jimmy will also contact the county about getting a rollback dumpster for the school so we can do more town cleanup.

Ann bought a new vacuum for the community center.

Lee will call about the street light in front of the Pierce residence. Jimmy mentioned that he spoke with Mt. Wheeler and they said a security light is \$28 per month and about \$50 to install it. He also mentioned that he wants to annex more people into the town limits of Lund.
