Minutes of Meeting for

May 9, 2023

Lorin Peacock brought the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance done.

Public Comment: None

Lorin Peacock asked about the minutes, asked if Jimmy will be spraying the town for weeds, he mentioned that the BLM once stated if we complain of weeds they will eradicate.
