Minutes of Meeting for

May 11, 2021

After the pledge, Chairman Jim Allred brought the meeting to order. Gilbert Griffin started the Public Comment by asking if the dumpster brought to the Community Center Square will be dumped more than once. Was informed that it will be taken on May 13, 2021. Gilbert also asked if all entities in the community including businesses can you it. Jim Allred informed him that yes it is for all the community, business included. Jim Allred will be calling Courtney at the DOT and asking them to dump and bring it back. This saves the DOT money to not have to go to individuals.
