

## Minutes of meeting for July 14, 2020 Lund Town Council

Chairman, Jim Allred brought the meeting to order. Pledge was said by all in attendance.

Sheriff Scott Henriod was present for questions by residents of White River Valley. Several residents were concerned over the high rate of speed the motorist travel through town and what are the options to get help and making changes motorist will recognize. Sheriff Henriod explained that it's a County wide problem in all towns and he is severely short of man power at present and is working towards improving this in his office. Some residents had several ideas, for example, putting police like cars parked along Hwy 318, additional speed limit signage and purchasing a speed trailer that is solar powered and can be maintained locally. Sheriff Henroid reminded residents that these rules and concerns apply to everyone not just for the speedy motorist and we should all take measures to ensure their families and neighbors safety, He will help in writing letters and speaking to others about the communities concerns.

Lee Ringueberg made a motion to approve the minutes of June 9 2020 and Lance Matheson seconded it, all members approved. Lee made a motion to approve the 1 voucher presented for secretary's wages and Lance seconded it, all members approved. There was no discussions about any activities that may be coming up in the area nor concerning the roads or street light maintenance.
