Minutes of Meeting for

September 14, 2021

After the pledge, Chairman Jimmy Allred brought the meeting to order. Jimmy started the public comment by mentioning that he hasn't quite finished the letter to the NDOT. He will be trying to finish it up soon. Also he has talked with LT Simon of the Highway Patrol and they will be working on patrolling Lund, after speaking with Kelly Barney he mentioned they are required to do so many inspections in Lund.
